The school has 2341 students (1142 Boys and 1199 Girls) and 192 staff members on its roll & gives equal importance to the academic and co-curricular activities.

3. ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE & ACHIEVEMENTS

The Class XII (AISSCE) and Class X (AISSE) results of the Academic Year 2021-'22 really proved that the students and teachers chased perfection to catch excellence. They were golden records in the history of Viswaiyothi.

Class XII

In Class XII (AISSCE), our School topper TREESA ALEX of Commerce Stream scored 99.6% marks and got ALL INDIA RANK 2 & KERALA STATE TOPPER. She has scored centum in Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics and Maths.

Out of the 120 students appeared, 118 passed out with distinction and 2 with high first class. 27 students got all A1 and 32 students scored 100/100 in different subjects.

Sivapriya G is the Humanities Stream Topper with 99.4% and Anjali Ann Jose is the Science Stream topper with 98.8 %.

Class X

The Class X (AISSE) result was glorious with distinguished distinctions. Out of the 169 students appeared, 159 passed out with distinction. Master Abel Shijo was the school topper with 99.6% marks. 33 students scored full 100 in different subjects. 25 students got all A1.

- In the CBSE State Kalotsav-2022, conducted at Carmel Public School, Vazhakkulam, 29 students participated. Two students got first Prize, one second prize and 27 students got A Grade.

- In the Vidyodaya Table tennis tournament, we were the Runner up in the Senior Boys' category.
- Swarna Benny, Sanjay Sivadas and George Christie were selected for the Kerala State Junior Athletics Championship 2022 held at Calicut University
- Johan Jenson Meleth of class XI got selected for the state camp for the National Youth Basketball Championship to be held at Indore.

SWIMMING

The swimming team proved their wonderful swimming spirit in the District/State/National levels and in all categories they participated.

- In the 14th Ekm Dt Swimming Championship at MTMHSS, Pampakkuda, our students won medals
- In the 20th Ekm Dt Junior and Sub Junior Swimming Championship held at MA College, Kothamangalam, Joseph V Jose, (XA) Caren Benny (VIIIC) and David John Jijo were the Individual Champions.
- In the 48th Junior and 38th Sub-Junior Kerala State Swimming Championship held at Thiruvananthapuram we got 21 gold,12 silver,9 bronze medals. Nicole Poly became the Individual Champion.
- Six members of our team represented Kerala state in the 48th Junior National Aquatic Championship 2022 in Odisha.
- We were Overall Champions in the VISIO Aqua Meet 2022 at Chavara Darsan Public School, Koonammavu. Caren Benny, Nicole Poly, & Gayathri Dev were Individual Champions.

- Caren Benny [VIII C] and Gayatry Dev [IX D] of our swimming team participated in the 36th National Games for swimming at Gujarat.
- In the CBSE South Zone swimming championship held at National Public School, Banglore, we had a delightful victory. We are Overall Champions, Champions in boys' category and Champions in girls' category scoring 11 Gold, 19 silver and 19 bronze swimming faster than 48 schools from Karnataka, Maharashtra, Goa, Kerala and Lakshadweep.

CBSE NATIONAL SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIP 2022- '23

In the CBSE National Swimming Championship, Viswajyothi won the Overall Championship. The swimmers won 18 gold,23 silver and 6 bronze and total 146 points. 30 students from our school participated and 24 of them won medals. 1300 students from 73 schools participated.

• The School Annual Sports Meet -2022 was inaugurated on 11th November by Mr. Regi Mathew, Municipal Chairperson, Angamaly. Opal House was crowned as the champion.

Skating

- Master. Anandjith Sarathkumar of II B won a silver Medal (200 mts ring ace) and Bronze Medal in 1000 mts ring race in the Kerala State Skating Championship at Vadakara Municipal Indoor stadium.
- Kumari Ahalya Sarathkumar of Class IVB won a bronze medal in 200 m race in District Skating Championship held at Perumbayoor.

Golf

Kum Krishna B of VII D participated in Indian Golf Union South Zone Junior Golf Championship held at CIAL and emerged as winner.
